



RESPONSIBILITIES OF REFERRING AGENCY

- Attend & respectfully participate
- Identify lead representatives
- Respect & follow relevant privacy legislation and agency policy and protocols
- Support communication of collaborative throughout home agencies
- Follow-up on agreed upon action items
- Provide updates on action items

WHAT?

A group of service providers who meet monthly to hear about people who meet specified criteria and are believed to be at risk.

WHO IS HIGH RISK?



- Individuals facing a number of risk factors affecting multiple areas of life.
- High likelihood of something bad happening and happening soon.

HIGH RISK SITUATIONS

- Sexual violence
- Trauma
- Lack of supports
- Missing school/work
- Physical violence
- Mental health crisis
- Suicide
- Crime victimization
- Poverty
- Homelessness

HPE - LLG - KFLA ABI/MHA COLLABORATIVES

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

- 16 years of age or older
- Lives in Southeastern Ontario
- Evidence of moderate to severe ABI
- Evidence of mental illness or substance use disorder
- Presence of high-risk situation
- Unmet needs

WHEN



A referral should be made when an agency:

- Exhausts own resources
- Exhausts resources available through existing community collaboration.
- Obtains consent from individual.

WHO ATTENDS THE COLLABORATIVE?



- ABI/MHA Collaborative **Core Member Agencies.**
- **Guests:** with consent, outside agencies are called upon on a case-by-case basis.
