WHO ATTENDS COLLABORATIVE?

- ABI/MHA Collaborative Core Member Agencies.
- Guests: with consent, outside agencies are called upon on a case-by-case basis.

A group of service providers who meet monthly to hear about people who meet specified criteria and are believed to be at risk.

- Individuals facing a number of risk factors affecting multiple areas of life.
- High likelihood of something bad happening and happening soon.
- Sexual violence
- Trauma
- Lack of supports
- Missing school/work
- Physical violence
- Mental health crisis
- Suicide
- Crime victimization
- Poverty
